Use each clue to work out what the initials stand for; a space is provided where you may write your answer.

The challenges vary greatly in difficulty. The answers may be, really, almost anything that could be linked to the clue, perhaps: facts; or myths; or a phrase; or quotation.

Some of the links are extremely tenuous. Every challenge includes a category. You may find more than one possible solution to a challenge. Considering the category might help you to choose between them.

Here is a couple of examples:

a, Initials: DMFP; Clue: Perry; Category: Food & drink; Answer: Drink Made From Pears

b, Initials: P,TH,FSPN; Clue: Pool; Category: Entertainment; Answer: Player, The

The quiz has a theme.

Specific brand names are mentioned. They are for your entertainment only. There is no intention to recommend any of them. Other brands are available, which you may find more, or less, appropriate.

This is the thirtieth quiz in an uninterrupted sequence.

Every year, for the past twenty-nine years, St. Paul's Church quiz sheets have been produced and sold during the Christmas season. Each quiz has featured a unique, and, we hope, testing set of challenges. The quiz is normally presented as a competition, where completed sheets may be returned for judging. Afterwards, winners have been declared and prizes awarded. Of course, the answers to the quiz could not be revealed until the deadline for submitting entries was passed. Proceeds from the sale of the sheets have contributed to Church funds.

We recognize some individuals have enjoyed the battle with the questions, incorporating the quiz into their celebrations; and so, we are determined to provide a 2020 version. This year though, the pandemic has caused us to revise the operation. Unfortunately, we cannot make arrangements to collect, and judge, the sheets, so the quiz is limited to being a personal endeavour, rather than a public contest.

In order to ensure the quiz may be distributed unhindered, this year, in addition to the conventional paper document, an 'electronic' version has also been created, which you may copy and forward as you wish.

Although the 2020 Christmas quiz is supplied free of charge, we do request you to consider making a small donation to church funds.

How did you do? Answer sheets, paper and 'electronic', will be available after 31st January 2021. (The judges feel the 2020 quiz has a similar level of difficulty to the 2019 quiz, where the winning entrant was declared, after mercilessly precise marking, to have found 93 correct answers.)

Thank you for your support. We have already begun to make plans for a 2021 quiz, which, we hope, will return to the normal format.
